Five Goal Areas

- All children are ready to start kindergarten.
- All third-grade students can read at grade level.
- All achievement gaps between students are closed.
- All students are ready for career and/or postsecondary education.
- All students graduate from high school.

Kindergarten Readiness

Goal:

By June 30, 2020, NRHEG Elementary School's Kindergarten Readiness percentages will meet or exceed the Minnesota State average.

Results:

Our district data indicates that we have met this goal.

- All students entering kindergarten age 5 or older
- All students entering kindergarten have provided record of immunizations
- All students entering kindergarten have been assessed with the Kindergarten Readiness Assessment Tool (KRAT).

Reading by Third-Grade

Goal:

By June 30, 2020, and continuing each year until 2024, the NRHEG third-grade reading scores will be at or above the third-grade state average of proficiency in reading, as measured by the MCA III reading assessments.

Results:

We are unable to report on the results of this goal due to COVID-19 disruptions in the spring of 2020.

Closing the Achievement Gaps

Goal:

Elementary Building: By June 30, 2020, 80% of students will increase reading proficiency by one grade's worth of growth based on their Fountas & Pinnell Reading Level.

Secondary Building: By June 30, 2020, as a school, the number of failing grades will be reduced by 25%.

Results:

We are unable to report on the results of this goal due to COVID-19 disruptions in the spring of 2020.

College and/or Career Readiness

Goal:

By June 30, 2024, the number of twelfth-grade students that have completed the Minnesota Career Information system activities (which include: the Career Cluster Survey, the Ideas & Interest Assessment, online portfolio, and career planning) will have increased from 0% in 2019 to 100%.

Results:

Currently, our district is on track to meet this goal. In 2019/2020, all eighth-grade students were entered into our Minnesota Career Information System platform, and staff became more intentional about integrating career awareness into the curriculum. These actions have put us in a position to successfully meet the subsequent parts of this goal by 2024.

All Students Graduate

Goal:

By June 30, 2020, NRHEG's four-year graduation rate will meet or exceed the Minnesota State Average.

Results:

This goal was met. Our district's graduation rate for 2020 was 91%. The state average was 84%.

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
